It puts me sad the fact that now I have to go, but I can guarantee you that I will never forget each one of you, and I wish that someday we

Guillermo first came to Galveston in 2011 after suffering a broken pelvis and severe road burns across the entire mid-section of his body. He has visited the Shriner's Hospital for Children more than 15 times for surgery and additional skin grafts, each time staying at the House. He and his Mom wrote these letters in appreciation to all those who have made his recovery at the House possible. Guillermo and his Mom were our last family to leave the house after our doors were shut by Covid. They traveled internationally back to their home in El Salvador. While we're happy for them, we have sad, mixed feelings to see them go. Guillermo is now studying psychology at Central American University and doing very well. We thank you, all of our supporters, who made this possible.

MISSION STATEMENT



Morgie WOMAN OF THE YEAR


