We are so glad that Beverly LaRock is a part of the Ronald McDonald House of Galveston family. She brings so much loving care to our House. Here's her story:

"My name is Beverly Ruth LaRock. I am 77 years old and a widow. I live alone with my two 10-year-old cats who are brothers. I have two children; my daughter lives in New York and my son lives in Galveston. I like reading and doing yoga. When I was a child, I had two surgeries because I had polio, and the hospital was five hours from my home. My parents would not stay in Baltimore because they could not afford a hotel. So, they registered me at the hospital and left to go home. They would come back two weeks later to take me home.

"It was lonely and a little scary. So, I wanted to volunteer at the Ronald McDonald house to help to keep the house working, so Parents would be able to stay with their children while they get treatment at Shriners and UTMB. My favorite part of volunteering is seeing and hearing the children learn and play with Miss Lidia in her classroom among other activities in the House. I would like to thank the wonderful staff that has treated me like family since I became a volunteer at the wonderful RMHG."
