VERY MUCH AT HOME Ivan's Story

Juchipila, Zacatecas, Mexico is a happy place that hosts many traditional fiestas.

Zacatecas is a beautiful large city with many fun and interesting places to visit.

Fifteen-year old Ivan de Jesus Garcia Arzate lives there with his parents, two brothers and a sister. He loves family dinners with his very close family. Like all teenagers, he enjoyed playing video games and riding his bike. But that happy life was disrupted when he had an accident at work.

Contact with a live electric wire burned him over 79% of his body, necessitating amputation of both his legs. He came to Galveston in early November 2021 with his mother, Arora Tacaobo Arcate. Ivan says he has the upmost respect to the medical staff for saving his life. "With God's help they treat us with love and respect. Every medical doctor, physiologist, surgeon, and everyone involved unite to help us."



Ivan and his mother have been staying at the Ronald McDonald House Galveston, where he says the location is key as the hospital is very close.

"The employees are nice, the House is peaceful, and we feel very much at home." And the House is his home for now, for an extended stay. His favorite things include meal donations for the families which allow them to feel like a family while eating together in the dining rooms. He also enjoys seeing the other families

Ivan says his goal is healing while learning to live with prosthetic legs. He is very much looking forward to the day when he can use those new legs and when he can go home to Zacatecas.

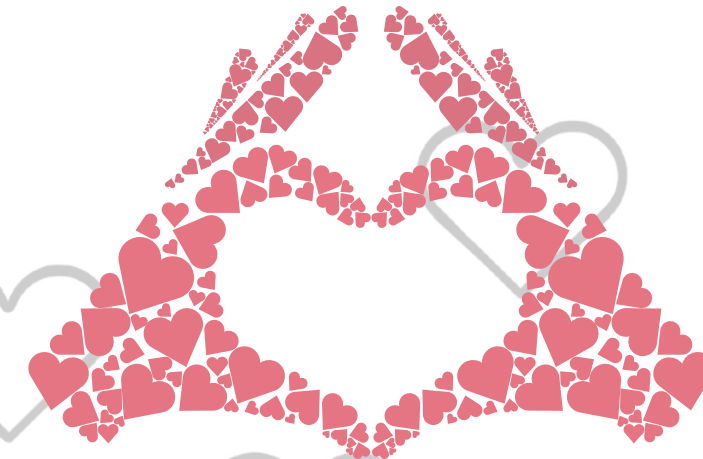
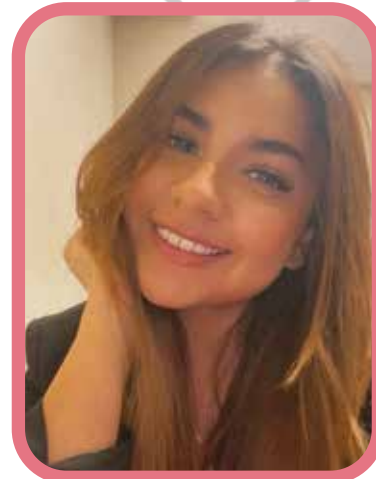

We have 8 families in the House and will increase that number soon. The families may use the Common areas again, one family at a time. We are finally able to welcome back our incredible, hard-working volunteers who have been fully vaccinated. We can be outside the House without masks, including the playground and paver walk, but must continue to wear them inside the House. As inconvenient as this seems sometimes, we do this to protect our very vulnerable burn children.

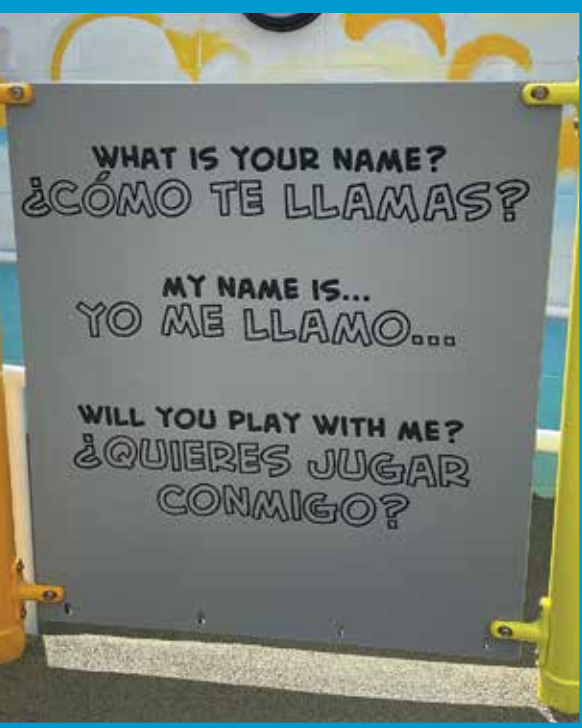
MISSION STATEMENT

The Ronald McDonald House of Galveston is a "home-away-from-home" for the families of children who are seeking medical treatment at University of Texas Medical Branch, Shriners Hospital for Children and Transitional Learning Center. The House is more than a place to stay; as an alternative to an isolated hotel room, the families and children enjoy cheerful surroundings and the support of other families, volunteers and staff.



A PLAY TIME STORY

With a lot of loving work involved



The original design of the House optimized the footprint to provide the best house possible to care for the children and their families, but there was little outdoor play space. More lots were gradually purchased, and the House was expanded with much more indoor play space, but still limited outdoor space. We purchased an additional adjacent house, donated it to the Galveston Historical Foundation, and had it moved. And now we had our outdoor space! Funding to build an adaptive play space which could accommodate wheelchairs, children with burns and other physical and medical limitations was another story.



The story continues. Dr. Frederick Fisher and his wife Adelaide survived the 1900 Galveston hurricane, but his brother's family perished, with the exception of their infant nephew, F. Kenner Fisher. Dr. and Mrs. Fisher adopted their nephew, but were devastated when he died suddenly at the age of 11. Dr. Fisher left a sizable bequest to St. Mary's Hospital for a park for children in honor of his Kenner. Because St. Mary's was no longer in existence, the Archdiocese of Galveston/Houston and trustees selected the Ronald McDonald House Galveston as the beneficiary of this



bequest meant for a play area for ill children. This was a huge windfall for the House, and the seed money for our playground.

Fredell Rosen and Susanne Sullivan had a vision and their committee started a capital campaign to supplement the funds. The Moody Foundation, the McDonald's Owner/Operators of Greater Houston/Galveston, the Bromberg Trust, the Sullivan Brothers Family of Companies and their employees, the Harris and Eliza Kempner Fund and numerous other local institutions and individuals stepped up with very generous donations, making our playground possible.

It was a monumental task. First, the area needed to be made flood-proof. Then there were the design and permitting processes. This is no ordinary playground.





The design includes a soft floor to cushion falls, Sunbrella sails to shade and protect burn patients, and wide spaces for accommodating wheel chairs. The plans called for attractive decoration and fun things such as colorful, Galveston-themed murals, movie screen, basketball court, bilingual learning stations and accessible equipment to attract kids with physical limitations. The staff and Susanne and Fredell's committees interviewed kids, toured similar facilities, and consulted with architects and medical professionals. Many, many people contributed their talents and expertise over a 4-year period with weekly meetings to figuratively and literally put their arms around all that needed to be accomplished. The box on the right just lists some of these. We thank them all. The project was made more difficult by the constraints of Covid and supply shortages. We are especially grateful to UTMB for their support of the project.

And now, we are just awaiting the finishing touches! While Covid protocols prevent us from welcoming you inside for now, we present the results here.

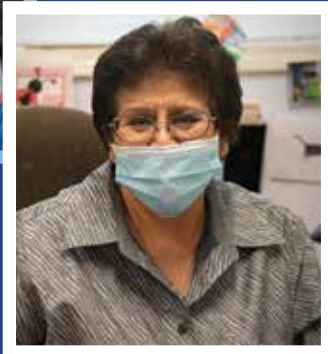

COVID AND THE HOUSE

Our RMHG Covid-19 story is a lot like all of yours; it's full of emotion, science and a sincere responsibility to keep everyone, especially our vulnerable children, safe.

With loving leadership, the Ronald McDonald House Global Charities organization established a strict and comprehensive protocol for all houses worldwide (in over 60 countries). UTMB and Shriners Hospitals have been fabulous partners the last two years, guiding us and providing knowledge, vaccinations and testing. Dr. Raimor, UTMB President, has been there for us from our first frantic phone call. Dr. Philip Keiser, chair of the UTMB COVID-19 Vaccination Task Force and Galveston County Health Authority, has been absolutely instrumental in helping us keep our families, special needs children and staff safe. Both UTMB and Shriners have been patient and understanding of the strict RMHG protocols. Dr. Pat Lanier, VP of House Operations during the pandemic, has been a tireless angel in coordinating it all in conjunction with Margie. Dr. Pat and Margie wrote, revised and re-revised a comprehensive reinstatement protocol plan, and then trained and retrained and re-retrained the employees as knowledge and conditions changed. It's been a team effort.



And we have been so successful! That is until very recently, when two of our RMHG children tested positive during weekly testing. The good news is both were vaccinated and asymptomatic, but we had to release them back to Shriners Hospital care. Our staff followed all protocol and went above and beyond in handling this situation. Shriners immediately tested all of the other children. Dr. Keiser sent UTMB's Ms Sciba and her team to the house to test all staff and parents/guardians, and to administer vaccinations and boosters. This was absolutely a godsend.

Ben and Heather Peterek with Gulfside Cleaning were miracle workers, coming as soon as contacted to virucidal fog all possible areas of contamination. The Petereks, longtime members of our RMHG family, were instrumental in helping us get our house reopened once Covid-19 hit town. For those of you who don't know, our indoor playground is named after their very special angel, Daisy.

Of course none of this would be possible without the magnificent leadership of our Executive Director, Margie Chavarria, and all of our dedicated staff. They have gone above and beyond in training, responsibility and hard work. Please keep all of them in your thoughts and prayers, as well as our special children and families who stay in the house that love built!

And when you see any of these lovely people please say thank you. And when it's safe to hug them, go big! We love our RMHG family.
